be seen, recognised and supported as a carer

- Get immediate support from someone who understands caring
- Be helped to understand the impact caring has on their wellbeing
- Join the Carers' Register to keep informed about support available
- Find peer support from other carers locally
- Identify new avenues of support available to everyone that might be helpful
- Sign up for a Carers Emergency Card, which sets out an emergency plan to give peace of mind

ANY CARER CAN...

get specific help relevant to their individual caring role

- Access specialist 1-2-1 support
- Get help around welfare entitlement
- Access training to support with practical tasks and wellbeing
- Accessing relevant things online
- Applying for relevant grants
- Access specific supports around life transitions and bereavement
- Understanding how to access a short break

AND...

be supported with a formal needs assessment and support plan

- This sets out the help you need to continue in your caring role for as long as you wish to.
- Funding can also be arranged to assist with this through a direct payment.
